Mission Statement

Our mission is to honor the legacy of a remarkable man who dedicated his life to helping others, fostering growth, and nurturing a passion for the appraisal profession. We are committed to continuing his work by alleviating the financial challenges future appraisers face during their training journey.

We pave the way for a stronger and more vibrant future for our profession, by easing the cost burden of qualifying education and investing in appraiser trainees.

George Harrison's profound dedication to the profession and his unwavering belief in the significance of quality education led him to establish the Columbia Institute and play a pivotal role as a co-founder of the NAA. Our fund is a testament to this commitment.

Scholarship Levels*

- <u>Longhorn Scholarship</u> designed to attract new entrants to the appraisal profession (up to \$1,500 based on individual state requirements for licensure (79 hours and under in most states)
- Alamo Scholarship designed to assist an applicant who has started the first level of QE licensing process but needs assistance to complete the first level of QE licensing process. (up to \$750 based on individual state requirements for licensure-79 hours and under in most states)

Both the Longhorn and Alamo Scholarships are designed to assist students enrolling in Basic Appraisal Principles/QE1; Basic Appraisal Procedures/QE2; USPAP/QE3; and the 4hr Supervisor/Trainee course.

Scholarship Requirements

- Applicants must complete the online application, submit a current resumé to include references and a written essay (in your own words, minimum 400 words) stating why the applicant would like to enter the Appraisal Profession, and why they should be considered for the scholarship.
- Eligible recipients may receive only one GRHS.
- Applications will be reviewed quarterly, and qualified recipients will be notified by email and/or phone and subsequently announced at the ACTS and Appraisal Summit conferences.

Additional Rewards

- Scholarship recipients will receive a free one-year NAA Associate Membership.
- Scholarship recipients will receive one comped registration to the ACTS <u>or</u> Appraisal Summit conference (this does not include travel, hotel, or miscellaneous expenses).

Conditions

Scholarship recipients have up to three months to register and begin QE coursework. Recipients must complete coursework within six months, exceptions could be made on a case-by-case basis. All scholarship monies will be paid directly to course providers.

Recipients will be billed for any coursework not completed/class withdrawals.
